Community Chef agrees to:

1. Fill out and return completed Chef Agreement Form.
2. Provide approx. 300 (1 - 2 ounce) samples of your signature dish - think "Costco". (Bring food already prepared.)
3. Provide your own serving utensils, extension cords and heating elements; ex. crockpots, sterno, etc. (Cooking is **NOT** allowed at the event).
4. **Request for access to electrical outlets must be made by September 1st.**
5. Arrive, check-in, set-up between 4:30 - 5:00 on day of event.
6. **Continue serving until the event closes at 8:30!**
7. Agrees to only use **Men Can Cook** promotional materials provided by or approved by the WRC.
8. Limit personal / business marketing materials to business cards and/or brochures within your individual serving area.
9. **Political campaigning is prohibited at all WRC events.**
10. **NO outside Alcohol Beverages allowed!**
11. When making your Signature Dish -
hand-held food or hors d'oeuvres are ENCOURAGED!

WRC agrees to:

1. Will provide each chef with 1/2 of an 8 foot table for food prep and serving (you will be sharing a table with another chef).
2. Will provide assistance with event set-up and clean-up.
3. Will provide small plates, napkins & utensils - if you need small bowls or cups, you must let the WRC know by September 1st.
4. **Chef and his ONE GUEST will need to sign in to be admitted to the event.**
(ALL other guests attending with the Chef will be directed to ticket sales)
